The production of knitwear products has been launched at this enterprise. The manufactured products were put on sale in special stores of the enterprise in the cities of Toragorgan, Namangan and Andijan. The volume of work increased year by year, while the domestic market was secured, the products began to be exported abroad. 90% of the company's employees are women. The system of hot food and transport was introduced to the workers.

In Eastern nations, the family is considered a sacred place. It's not for nothing, of course. From the first years of independence, family and women's issues were considered at the level of state policy. Taking into account that the strength of the state is inextricably linked to the strength of its families, 1998 was declared the "Year of the Family" in our country. In this regard, the Republican "Family" scientific-practical center was established. Being one of the first, a branch of this center was also established in Namangan region. The management of this new system was entrusted to Dilbar Zohidova, one of the passionate women of the region. In this field, practical work was carried out on issues such as finding solutions to family problems and preventing family disputes. In 2000, Dilbar Zohidova was appointed head of the Namangan Region branch of the "For a Healthy Generation" fund. The foundation under the leadership of Dilbar Zokhidova has done many good things. In particular, he sponsored the "Chortoq" children's hospital in the region, the "Mother and Child" screening centers, and the "Children's Garden and Wellness Center" included in the State program was established in Davlatabad. Since 2002, Dilbar Zokhidova, who is used to being active, started doing business. Under his leadership, the private enterprise "Oybarshah" was launched. Due to her hard work, Dilbar Zohidova was awarded with the "Badge of Independence", the "Sign of Honor" order, the "For Passionate Work" medal, and the "Excellence of Public Education of Uzbekistan" badge.

DISCUSSION

The farmer Patilakhan Ergasheva, who was awarded the title of "Hero of Uzbekistan" for his effective work on the development of Uzbekistan, and the skilled pedagogue Manzurakhan Madaliyeva are famous not only in the Fergana Valley, but throughout Uzbekistan. In the early years of independence, cotton became important in the economy of our country as white gold. Due to the trust in his work and responsibility, the "Fergana-3" seed was tested for the first time in his brigade. The hard work of a hardworking person has yielded more results than expected. During her career, the Mirishkor woman from Buvaida was able to create a unique school in the development of cotton growing, which is the

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main branch of agriculture. Effectively using her many years of experience, this female farmer achieved high results. Just one example, in 2019, they grew Namangan-77 cotton on 30 hectares of land, harvested more than 125 tons, and increased the annual contract plan by 127 percent. It is impossible not to acknowledge the efforts of our selfless women like Motabarkhan Rakhimova, Matluba Otajonova, and Fatima Jorayeva as members of this farm in achieving such productivity. Patilakhan Ergasheva's services to the country were duly appreciated, in 2010 she was awarded the title of "Hero of Uzbekistan".
