So by this period, in addition to the growing material and spiritual interests of children, sexual needs count from strong sources of personality activity, which begins to manifest itself in various psychological and social forms.

Another aspect of personality maturity is socio-economic maturity. It implies that a person can provide for himself and his own family independently financially. Of particular importance in the family development of young people is their economic independence. In this place, too, there are different age limits, young people, some of whom, as early as 18-19 years old, can achieve economic independence from their parents' family, while others, even at the age of 25-30, use the financial support of their fathers.

Among these maturation aspects, it is most complicated to talk about the spiritual and moral maturity of an individual. Because a clear criterion and description of this aspect has not yet been developed.

Thus, the concept of "maturity" embodies many aspects in itself. It is worth mentioning that the concept of "maturity" is necessarily inextricably linked with a certain life experience, that is, with "vital knowledge". There are also specific individual characteristics of "mastering vital knowledge", passing through "life universities".
