The main part. What does the word method mean? Method is a Greek word that means "study" or "way of knowing". This concept has philosophical and didactic meanings. In the philosophical sense, the concept of "method" means observing the phenomena of nature and society and approaching reality from a scientific point of view. In the didactic sense, this concept refers to ways of equipping students with knowledge, skills and abilities. Issues





related to the teaching of certain subjects are studied by a special methodology. Therefore, educational methods are of great interest to both scientists and methodologists . Among the main methods used in teaching the Uzbek language, the following can be distinguished:

1. Grammar translation method : This method is one of the oldest methods of language teaching , based on the study of grammatical rules and translation of words.

2. Communicative approach : This method is based on engaging students in the language through communicative skills. The lessons are aimed at developing communication and speech competence.

3. Interactive methods : ensuring the active participation of students in the learning process is carried out by using various games, role-playing games and group work.

The organization of foreign language teaching using the interactive learning model confirms the correctness of the following conclusions:

2. If the teacher actively supports the students' educational tools , they learn very well;

3. If the teacher, firstly, is able to choose effective means of learning based on the capabilities of the students, and secondly, takes into account their opinion, even if it does not agree with his own opinion, then the students will learn what they want. they study science.

In the process of teaching the Uzbek language to students, the presence of an interactive process not only negates the "power" of the teacher, but also makes it possible to assess the student's level of knowledge, identify achievements and shortcomings. Another advantage of the interactive process :

- expression of students' personal opinion;

- to defend one's views;

- listening to other people's opinions, summarizing them, identifying the main, important and real ones from the opinions expressed, developing the ability to draw conclusions;

- the correct and effective use of interactive methods in the educational process consists in improving skills and competencies.



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Therefore, a skillful and artistic approach to the educational process, organizing it according to needs, is one of the important conditions for raising a perfect person, and each student has his own idea .

It is known that today there are more than a hundred types of interactive methods, most of which have been tested and have given good results. Effective results can be achieved in the lesson by using the widely used methods - "Cluster", "Brainstorming", "Continue", "Presentation", "Blitz survey", "Problem situation". "Sinquain", "Reverse Test", "Wheel of Mind" methods are used in the part of the lesson to ask about the passed topic, "Insert", "Pinboard", "Zinama-Zina", "Boomerang" technologies in the part of explaining the new topic, in the part of strengthening the topic Graphic organizers such as Venn Diagram, Fishbone, Why?, How?, Concept Chart, Lily Flower, and Concept Analysis, T-Table, Resume, The use of "Sunflower", "Charkhpalak" methods, "FSMU", "Cluster", "BBXB" methods for homework help to ensure the effectiveness of the lesson and increase the knowledge of students. In addition to the above-mentioned interactive methods, didactic games such as "Yes...no", "Find the owner of the definition", "Who am I?", "Domino" can be used in the native language and literature classes. During the game, the students behave freely and want to show their knowledge. As a result, confidence and determination appear in the student. Learns to engage in debate. He is used to justifying his opinion. The age and level of education of students should be taken into account .

Summary. In conclusion, we can say that modern methods of teaching the Uzbek language are important in attracting students to the language, developing linguistic competence and forming practical skills. Increasing the effectiveness of teaching by improving the methods serves to strengthen the position of the Uzbek language in the international arena. At the same time, the introduction of new technologies and didactic materials into the educational process makes language teaching more interactive and attractive.
