You should try to make your instructions as accurate as possible. It is unlikely that the group will be able to perceive more than one or two, even very specific, instructions at the same time, so the instructions should be written on the board or cards. Give the group enough time to complete the task.

When it comes to the practical application of technologies, it is absolutely not necessary to use one technology. The best way was to combine several educational technologies, combining the best of them.

Since we are engaged in the integration of modern educational technologies in the process of teaching a foreign language in order to form an independent education of a student, it is necessary to carefully study the innovative ideas of modern Uzbek and foreign teachers for several years. To reveal the subjective experience of the student, to form educational methods of work that are personally significant for him, to educate moral ideals, to develop critical thinking,

it is concluded that this is a pedagogical system that helps to adequately assess and selfcontrol.
